- An increased number of Conversation questions (Part 3)



UPDATES TO THE LISTENING SECTION (CONTINUED)

- Conversations will include more natural language such as more and shorter interactions between speakers
- Some conversations will include more than two speakers



UPDATES TO THE LISTENING SECTION (CONTINUED)

- New questions testing the understanding of what is said in a conversation or talk about written information
- New questions about understanding the speaker's words in context

UPDATES TO THE READING SECTION

- A reduced number of Incomplete Sentence questions (Part 5)
- A small increase in the next of Text Completion questions (Part 6)
- A small increase in the number of Single- and Multiple-Passage questions (Part 7)



UPDATES TO THE READING SECTION (CONTINUED)

- Text Completion questions (Part 6) will have a different format
- Some reading passages will represent examples of written conversations like text messages, instant messages, or online conversations
- Some question sets will be based on three written sources



UPDATES TO THE READING SECTION (CONTINUED)

- Two new question types testing understanding of the overall organization of passages
 - Text Completion questions (Part 6) that ask test takers to choose which new sentence fits best in the context of the overall passage
 - Set-Based questions (Part 7) that ask test takers to understand where in the passage a sentence belongs
- New questions about understanding the writer's words in context
